ORDER

Extension in provisional recognition is hereby granted to **DIVYA PUBLIC SCHOOL, SECTOR 44, CHANDIGARH** in pursuance of Article 235 read with 241-A of Punjab Education Code 1956 for the period from 01.04.2023 to 31.03.2025 (to regulate the previous period) and further from 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2027, subject to the conditions that the school should ensure that all the conditions as given below are complied within six months before the expiry of the period of recognition failing which further recognition would not be considered:-

1. Provisions of RTE Act and other instructions issued by the Education Department related to admission of students under EWS category and disadvantaged groups be followed in letter and spirit (wherever applicable).
2. Reserve Fund is maintained in the name of DEO, U.T., Chandigarh equal to 02 months' salary of the teaching/non-teaching staff.
3. School will follow land allotment conditions and other notifications/orders/instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time
4. Salary being paid to the teachers and other staff is less than the approved DC Rates, the same should be paid as per provision of Appendix-I of CBSE affiliation Bye Laws;
5. School will follow the provision of Rules of Recognition of Punjab Education Code;
6. No particular book shop be prescribed for purchase of book/uniform etc. by the school and Instructions/guidelines issued by CBSE relating to books/uniforms are to be followed;
7. Fire Safety Norms be followed meticulously and there should be no laxity in this regard on the part of the school and complete Fire Safety Certificate from the Fire Department, UT, Chandigarh be submitted to this office;
8. Staff engaged should be fully qualified as per NCTE notifications issued from time to time and untrained teachers should be replaced with trained ones;
9. Recognition is liable to be withdrawn if the management or the staff of the school take part in agitation against the authority of Government, or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against Government or of enmity and hatred between different classes or if the pupils are permitted to attend political meetings or to engage in any form of political or communal agitation;
10. Government reserves to itself the right, to grant, refuse or withdraw recognition at its entire discretion.
11. The management will not add any more class/section to the school without the permission of the department;
12. The school will not be transferred to a different Managing Body already approved by the Department;

The recognition is also subject to further the following conditions: -

1. School Managing Committee is to be approved from Education Department, Chandigarh Administration.
2. That as per provisions of Section 5 of the Punjab Regulation of Fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016 extended to the U.T., Chandigarh w.e.f. 13.04.2018, increase in fee shall not exceed eight per cent of the fee of the previous year.
3. That admission of 25% students under EWS category and Disadvantaged Group students be made as per Section 12 of the RTE Act, 2009 upto 8th class and 15% from 9th class to 10th class as per Land Allotment Policy.
4. That the teachers who do not fulfill the minimum qualifications as per NCTE guidelines need to acquire minimum qualification or replacing them with qualified teachers.
5. The Reserve Fund is to be pledged in the name of DEO, U.T., Chandigarh as per rules.
6. That the school shall prepare its annual report for each academic year as per Section 19 of "The Punjab Regulation of Fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016 (as extended to Union Territory of Chandigarh) and Rules 6 & 7 of "The Chandigarh Union Territory Regulation of Fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Rules, 2019" and submit the same to the DEO, UT, Chandigarh.
7. In future, the school will apply for extension in recognition well before the expiry of extension period otherwise failing which action against the said school will be taken as per rule.

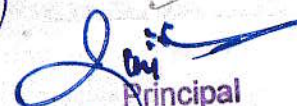
